



## **PAST GRAND CHANCELLORS OF THE GRAND LODGE KNIGHTS OF PYTHIAS OF THE DOMAIN OF NORTH CAROLINA\***

In late 1870, William Augustine Jobson, who was Deputy Grand Chancellor for North Carolina, corresponded with John B. Vaughan, a member of Jefferson Lodge #23 of Richmond, Va. in regard to organizing a Lodge in Wilmington, NC. The result of this correspondence lead Supreme Chancellor Samuel Read to undertake the institution of Stonewall Lodge #1 in North Carolina.

### **THE GRAND LODGE OF NORTH CAROLINA**

\*Instituted December 21, 1871 at Wilmington, NC by Supreme Chancellor, Samuel Read at Pythian Castle Hall on Third Street.

The first meeting adjourned to meet in Fayetteville,NC on January 24, 1872 for completion of its business with Supreme Chancellor Read attending.
